The plan of work was therefore revised. While the book is still largely the story of the national refuges, enough of the history and status of all types of refuges in North America has been included to give an overall picture of present conditions. The greatly enlarged scope of the work has required the omission of many interesting phases of this fascinating conservation story. However, within space limitations, the details that make the refuge story such a gripping drama for those who have been privileged to have a part in it have been retained.
